# **Directions from the airport**

## Getting out of the airport and onto the motorway:

- 1) **Turn right** out of the car hire park
- 2) **Turn right** on the tiny round-a-bout after 300yrds join a two lane, probably busy road get in left lane
- 3) At bigger round-a-bout **take 2nd exit (on left)** and keep left to go down motorway slip road (avoiding misleading right slide option)
- 4) Relax you are now on the **A56 motorway**

## More motorway directions:

- 5) Shortly you'll keep left to **transition onto the A1** then keep right to turn off at next slip road onto the **E842** sign posted **Salerno**
- 6) Generally heading towards Salerno and **Reggio Calabria** is good, Roma and Caserta is bad. **Vesuvius** will be on your right...
- 7) Keep left as pretty soon you take another slip road to Salerno and the **A30**

8) A30 becomes the **A2** towards Salerno (but don't go into the city) and then the **E45** towards **Pontecagnano** and Battipaglia.

## Get off at Battipaglia:

- 9) Look for green sign "Battipaglia" and then look for "Paestum SS18"
- 10) Drive for a long time (initially past loads of Mozzarella shops) road becomes the **SP430** after Agropoli

#### Go to Palinuro:

10) Eventually you'll get an exit marked "**Poderia**" and with smaller, brown signs to "**Palinuro**" and "**Marina di Camerota**":



11) Keep going towards **Palinuro**, after a while you'll get to a round-about - take the right turning to Palinuro, and then once on outskirts of Palinuro take right at another round-about - you will be seeing signs to **Pisciotta**.

#### Driving back up the coast:

- 12) Drive along the coastal road, go up a hill and then look for a left turn marked "**Scalo Pisciotta**" take it. Awkward turning (if you miss it you go to Pisciotta borgo and then have to drop down towards the Marina but turn off after 6 hairpins 2<sup>nd</sup> right)
- 13) Drive past/through the **station car park** and then look out for an awkward left turning on to Via Vecchia Stazione(immediately after the **Carabinieri** station (on right) with the Osteria Vecchia Stazione on left.
- 14) Go over the **old railway viaduct** low lights after dark and then take short slip road right, up to the apartment.

In/around Pisciotta asking for directions to "stazione vecchia" should be productive. The apartment block is No. 8

**Note:** this route avoids the more logical northern approach to Pisciotta – but that means you miss out the difficult, land-slide prone roadway after Ascea that requires confidence, daylight and a narrow car....
